NOTICE

Please take notice that Duke Energy Kentucky (DE-Kentucky) will be applying to the Kentucky Public Service Commission for approval to implement its Energy Efficiency rider rate under the Rider SAW (Save-A-Watt) for electric service and gas service for residential and non-residential customers. Upon approval, the Rider SAW rate to be applied to residential customer bills in \$0.001779/kWh for electric service and the rate applied to residential customer bills is \$0.004828/ccf for gas service. The Rider SAW rate to be applied to non-residential customer bills is \$0.000912.kWh.

The rate contained in this notice is the rate proposed by DE-Kentucky. However, the Public Service Commission may order a rate to be charged that differs from this proposed rate. Such action may result in a rate for consumers other than the rate in this notice. When Rider SAW is adjusted to replace and net out the effect of Rider DMSR the result in year one is a 0.2% increase in total residential electric rates, 0.2% increase in total non-residential rates and a 0.6% decrease in total residential gas rates.

Any corporation, association, body politic or person may by motion within thirty (30) days after publication or mailing of notice of the proposed rate changes request leave to intervene. The motion shall be submitted to the Public Service Commission, 211 Sower Boulevard, P.O. Box 615, Frankfort, Kentucky 40602, and shall set forth the grounds for a request including the status and interest of the party.
