Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc., ("Duke Energy Kentucky") by and through its legal counsel, hereby submits this First Set of Interrogatories and Data Requests of Duke Energy Kentucky to The Kroger Co. ("Kroger"). Please forward to the undersigned on or before June 8, 2009, your responses to the following data requests:

DEFINITIONS

The following definitions apply throughout the discovery request and are deemed to be incorporated therein:

A. "Document" means and includes each and every written, recorded, or graphic matter of any kind, type, nature, or description that is or has been in your possession, custody, or control, or of which you have knowledge, including, but not limited to, computer files, computer databases, computer printouts, e-mail messages, correspondence, memoranda, tapes, stenographic or handwritten notes, written forms of any kind, charts, blueprints, drawings, sketches, artwork, graphs, plans, articles, specifications, diaries, letters, telegrams, photographs, labels, cartons, minutes, contracts, agreements, reports, surveys, data compilations of any kind and created or stored or transferred in any medium whatsoever, teletypes, telexes, facsimiles, invoices, order forms, checks, drafts, statements, receipts, credit memos, reports, summaries, books, ledgers, notebooks, schedules, transparencies, recordings, catalogs, advertisements, promotional materials, films, video tapes, audio tapes, brochures, or pamphlets, or any written or recorded materials of any other kind, however stored, recorded, produced, or reproduced, and

PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION also including, but not limited to, drafts or copies of any of the foregoing that contain any notes, comments, or markings of any kind not found on the original documents, or that are stored or produced in a different format or medium from the original documents, or that are otherwise not identical to the original documents.

B. "And" or "or" shall be construed conjunctively or disjunctively as necessary to make the requests inclusive rather than exclusive.

C. The term "you" and "your" refer to Kroger.

D. The term "person" means and includes natural persons, individuals, firms, corporations, partnerships, proprietorships, joint ventures, unincorporated associations, government agencies, and all other organizations or entities of any type.

E. The term "regarding" means consisting of containing mentioning, suggesting, reflecting, concerning, regarding, summarizing, analyzing, discussing, involving, dealing with, emanating from, directed at, pertaining to in any way, or in any way logically or factually connected or associated with the matter discussed.

F. The singular as used herein shall include the plural and the masculine gender shall include the feminine and the neuter.

G. "Identify" or "identifying" or "identification" when used in reference to a natural person means to state: the person's full name, present or last known (designating which) address and telephone number, and present or last known (designating which) business affiliation, job title, and employment address.

H. "Identify" or "identifying" or "identification" when used in reference to a person other than a natural person means to state: the full name of the person and any names under which it conducts business; the present or last known (designating which) address of the person; and, the present or last known (designating which) telephone number of the person.

I. "Identify" or "identifying" or "identification" when used in reference to a document means to provide with respect to each document requested to be identified by these discovery requests a description of the document that is sufficient for purposes of a request to produce or a subpoena duces tecum, including the following:

- 1) the type of document (e.g., letter, memorandum, etc.);
- 2) the date of the document; the title or label of the document;
- 3) the Bates number or other identifier used to number the document for use in litigation; the identity of the originator;
- 4) the identity of each person to whom it was sent;
- 5) the identity of each person to whom a copy or copies were sent;
- 6) a summary of the contents of the document;
- 7) the name and last known address of each person who presently has possession, custody or control of the document;

8) if any such document was, but is no longer, in your possession, custody or control or is no longer in existence, state whether it: (1) is missing or lost; (2) has been destroyed; or (3) has been transferred voluntarily or involuntarily, and if so, state the circumstances surrounding the authorization for each such disposition and the date of such disposition.

J.
