

Customer rates will increase by \$0.41 per 1,000 gallons used. The purposed change will be effective for service rendered on and after January 18, 2009.

Due to an increase in the Kentucky River Authority withdrawal fee, the Nicholasville Water Department has filed a proposed rate schedule to increase the rate for wholesale water service:

Dear All:

As you may be aware, the Kentucky River Authority, effective April 1, increased their Tier II withdrawal fee by \$0.044 per 1000 gallons. Since the withdrawal fee is a pass-through volume charge to all of the City's customers The attached ordinance will raise all volume charges to the City's customers by \$0.04 per 1000 gallons.

Late last year the KRA was originally planning on instituting the increase in the Tier II rate in late 09...and I was hoping that I would be able to address this issue when the rates are adjusted to pay for the expansion of the water treatment plant that is already underway...but unfortunately, this won't be able to wait that long.

The first half of the attached ordinance is a regurgitation of the rates currently in effect and the last half contains the new rates.... The Wholesale volume charge will change from \$1.81 per thousand gallons to \$1.85 per thousand gallons.

I also checked with Damon Talley about how PSC was handling these changes for rural water districts and he said that the PSC staff has a streamlined form that gives virtually immediate approval for the pass-through charge.

The City attorney is reviewing the attached and I will let you know of any changes that are made. Please call me at 885-9473 if you have any questions.
