My interest is that I have my grandparents home (they are deceased) in the Graham Ky area of Carter Co. About 6 yrs ago my husband, my mother, + myself decided to go with putting an electric furnace + heat pump so when we would go there it would be much better + convenient. Since we live in Dayton, Ohio + have Dayton Power + Light service Our house is twice the size + we pay a level bill of \$161.⁰⁰/_{xx} a month (with a free make up month for the year) Kentucky Power is saying that we used 3757 KWH ^(Dec 2009) when the only electric being used at this time with the furnace set on 64° is the furnace, heat pump, + a dehumidifier. The small church on the same road (which is struggling by the way) using only electric lights received a \$100.⁰⁰/_{xx} electric bill. They also only have 2 services a week + have their furnace on for only when they are there.

It amazed me when the Olive Hill Times reported that Michael Morris CEO of AEP according to Forbes magazine received 13.5 million in 2007 with a 3 year total compensation of \$22.3 million. I think this says it all. I think as with the rest of the country that this is why the economy is suffering. The greed of some is causing the average family who has worked for a living like myself to suffer.

It is my hope that you will take my plea serious + say "no" to the Kentucky Power Co. + they will be turned down for this request now + in the future.
