Dear KU,



Our electric bill has tripled for some reason this winter so far. We are doing nothing different than last winter. We will not survive if there is that much of an increase again. We believe KU has already raised the rates as does other KU customers. I have spoken to my mother and her bill and my grandmothers have more than doubled as well.

I realize that KU employees have to be paid but there should be reconsideration on the proposed increase immediately.
