Informal Conference Memorandum

A telephonic informal conference ("IC") was held in this matter on Tuesday, March 17, 2009. A copy of the conference attendance list is attached. The purpose of the IC was to discuss the Attorney General's Motion to Set a Procedural Schedule, which was filed with the Commission on February 19, 2009.

During the course of the IC, the parties discussed the following:

- The Assistant Attorney General stated that he has asked all of the questions he wished to pose to Cincinnati Bell. He stated that he did not see the basis for holding a formal hearing. He stated that he would like Cincinnati Bell to supplement the record regarding the availability of emergency information and certain customer information in the Yellow Pages directory distributed within Cincinnati Bell's Kentucky service area.
- Cincinnati Bell stated that it would file the supplement this week.
- The Assistant Attorney General stated that he would file comments into the record this week. He stated that within the comments he would move to withdraw his motion to set a procedural schedule and would also state that he is waiving his right to hold a formal hearing in this matter.
- The parties asked Commission Staff about the timeline for concluding this proceeding. Commission Staff stated that they would ask the Commission to move expeditiously in issuing a final Order.

The informal conference then adjourned.
