Pursuant to the Commission's February 23, 2009 Order, on April 2, 2009, representatives of East Kentucky Power Cooperative ("EKPC") and Commission Staff ("Staff") met at the Commission's offices to discuss EKPC's testimony and responses to the first round of data requests in the current examination of the company's environmental surcharge mechanism. Additional attendees included representatives from Owen Electric Cooperative ("Owen") and a representative from Gallatin Steel Company ("Gallatin"). Owen and Gallatin's representatives were participating as intervenors in this proceeding. A list of attendees is attached to this memorandum as Attachment 1.

Commission Staff asked clarifying questions related to information included in the first data request. The topics discussed were related to the two-month true-up adjustment for the current over collection of the surcharge and the request to implement a two-month true-up adjustment to the surcharge mechanism, operations and maintenance expenses, specifically the contract labor, and the SO2 and NOx Emissions Allowance Inventory. There was also discussion by EKPC and Owen of alternatives to a possible change to the retail pass-through mechanism to the member systems' customers. There being no other questions, the meeting was adjourned.
