#### NOTICE OF RATE INCREASE

Comes the Electric and Water Plant Board of the City of Frankfort ("FPB"), by and through counsel, and for its Notice of Rate Increase hereby states as follows:

Pursuant to KRS 278.190 FPB gives notice that it will adjust its existing rates for wholesale water service from \$1.539 per 1,000 gallons to \$1.822 per 1,000 gallons effective December 8, 2008.

In support of this increase, FPB notes that on June 6, 2008 it filed its proposed tariff increasing wholesale water rates. Thereafter, on July 2, 2008, the Commission entered an Order suspending the proposed rate for five months from July 7, 2008 to December 6, 2008.

KRS 278.190 notes "[i]f the proceeding has not been concluded and an order made at the expiration of five (5) months . . . the utility may place the proposed change of rate . . . in effect at the end of that period after notifying the commission, in writing, of its intention so to do."

WHEREFORE, pursuant to KRS 278.190 and the Commission's July 2, 2008 Order, FPB will adjust its wholesale rate from \$1.539 to \$1.822 per 1,000 gallons effective December 8, 2008.
