<u>ORDER</u>

This matter is before the Commission upon Kenergy Corp.'s ("Kenergy") motion to withdraw its application to provide a temporary, one-time reduction of its customer charge to all of Kenergy's non-direct serve customers beginning with the March 24, 2009 billing cycle. Kenergy's reasoning for seeking the rate reduction was to recognize the hardships its customers had to endure as a result of the January ice storms. Kenergy noted that, beginning with the March 24, 2009 billing cycle, Kenergy customers were being billed for service provided during the ice storms. Kenergy stated that the reduction in the bills would have been a direct partial setoff to the charges for service during the time in question.

On April 8, 2009, Kenergy's management, having not yet received approval of its application, decided that the gesture had lost its meaning and relevance. Kenergy now files its motion to withdraw its request for a temporary rate reduction.


Having reviewed the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that Kenergy has shown good cause to withdraw its application.
