ORDER

On February 20, 2009, Longview Land Company, LLC (“Longview”) submitted to the Commission its application for a rate adjustment. This application contained documents that clearly reveal the social security number and employer tax identification number of certain persons and business entities. Social security numbers and employer identification numbers are considered confidential and exempted from disclosure under the Kentucky Open Records Act.¹

Accordingly, the Commission, on its own motion, **HEREBY ORDERS** that:


1. The social security numbers and employer tax identification numbers contained in Longview’s application shall be afforded confidential treatment.
2. The Executive Director shall remove Longview’s application from the Commission’s public files and shall substitute a copy in which all social security numbers and employer tax identification numbers have been redacted.
