This location is highly visible from my property of residence at 281 Misty Drive, Misty Meadows sub-division, Somerset, Kentucky.

My property of residence is in a moderately populated sub-division, which still maintains a country, serene, natural setting. I feel that construction of the proposed tower would be detrimental to the landscape and natural beauty of the area. There are very few residential areas in Pulaski County that still possess a natural country setting.

There are numerous locations in the surrounding area with similar hilly landscapes that would appear to be equally as suitable for the construction of this tower as the proposed location. I believe, as do many others in my neighborhood, that another location should be considered before construction is started at the proposed location.
