The Ernest Alsip Road is the only entrance to our home, we have very active lives with work and school. My daughters play ball and we have to travel this road several times a day. This is a one lane road and meeting someone on the road is now and would be a greater inconvenience for my family. I also have some health problems, and my husband has high blood pressure and I believe the aggravation from backing up when another vehicle is approaching will affect his health.

My family use this one lane road for exercise. The surrounding neighbors also walk on this road. I believe this tower would create a lot of traffic flow and with no possible way to widen the road it would create a hardship for my family, and the school bus, and the postal service and any emergency vehicles.
