Enclosed for filing are an original and four (4) conformed copies of Duke Energy Kentucky's ("Duke") "Monthly Report of Gas Cost Calculations and Tariff Schedules," for the month commencing with the May 2009 revenue month in accordance with KPSC order dated November 6, 2003 in Case No. 2003-00386. This filing is based on supplier tariff rates expected to be in effect on May 1, 2009 and the NYMEX on April 7, 2009 for the month of May 2009.

The above described schedules and GCA are effective with the final meter readings of District 1, May 2009 revenue month (i.e., final meter readings on and after May 1, 2009).

Duke's proposed GCA is \$5.848 per Mcf. This rate represents an increase of \$0.164 per Mcf from the rate currently in effect for April 2009.

# RATE RS RESIDENTIAL SERVICE

#### **APPLICABILITY**

Applicable to firm natural gas service, which is comprised of commodity gas supply and local delivery service, required for all domestic purposes in private residences, single occupancy apartments, and common use areas of multi-occupancy buildings, when supplied at one point of delivery where distribution mains are adjacent to the premises to be served.

#### **NET MONTHLY BILL**

The Net Monthly Bill is determined as follows: All gas is billed in units of 100 cubic feet (CCF).

Customer Charge per month:

\$12.00

Plus the applicable charge per month as set forth on Sheet No. 63,

Rider AMRP, Accelerated Main Replacement Program

Delivery Gas Cost

Rate Adjustment Total Rate

Plus a commodity Charge for all CCF at \$0.26687 plus \$0.5848 Equals \$0.85167

Plus, all delivered gas shall be subject to an adjustment per CCF as set forth on Sheet No. 62, Rider DSMR, Demand Side Management Rate.

Plus, all gas delivered shall be subject to an adjustment per CCF as set forth on Sheet No. 64, Rider MSR-G, Merger Savings Credit Rider-Gas.

The "Customer Charge" shown above plus Rider AMRP shall be the minimum amount billed each month.

The "Gas Cost Adjustment" as shown above, is an adjustment per 100 cubic feet determined in accordance with the "Gas Cost Adjustment Clause" set forth on Sheet No. 70 of this tariff.

When bills are rendered less frequently than monthly the time related units such as cubic feet blocks, minimum or other charges, will be billed in accordance with the number of billing months in the meter reading interval.

#### LATE PAYMENT CHARGE

Payment of the Net Monthly Bill must be received in the Company's office within twenty-one (21) days from the date the bill is mailed by the Company. When not so paid, the Gross Monthly Bill, which is the Net Monthly Bill plus 5%, is due and payable.

#### **RATE GS**

#### **GENERAL SERVICE**

#### **APPLICABILITY**

Applicable to firm natural gas service, which is comprised of commodity gas supply and local delivery service, required for any purpose by an individual non-residential customer at one location when supplied at one point of delivery where distribution mains are adjacent to the premises to be served. This schedule is also applicable to non-metered natural gas commodity supplies and local delivery service for street lighting to such entities as certificated homeowners associations, businesses, and federal, state, and local governments. The Company may decline requests for service under this tariff due to gas supply limitations.

#### **NET MONTHLY BILL**

The Net Monthly Bill is determined as follows: All gas is billed in units of 100 cubic feet (CCF)
