## ORDER

On October 26, 2009, Hendron Water District ("Hendron") gave notice, by letter, that it intended to place its proposed rates into effect subject to refund. The notice was made pursuant to KRS 278.190(2). The Commission finds that it is unable to complete its investigation within the suspension period and that Hendron has complied with the statutory provisions to place the proposed rates into effect.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Hendron shall maintain its records in such manner as will allow determination of any amount to be refunded, in the event one is ordered upon final resolution of this matter.
- 2. Within 15 days of the date of this Order, Hendron shall file with the Commission revised tariff sheets reflecting its rates. The form of the revised tariff sheets must comply with 807 KAR 5:011, Section 3.
