
## <u>ORDER</u>

On June 19, 2009, Green River Valley Water District ("Green River Valley") applied to the Commission for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to upgrade transmission mains, water storage facilities, and two existing steel clearwells. Green River Valley also requested the Commission to authorize a loan from the Kentucky Rural Water Finance Corporation ("KRWFC") to fund projects.

KRS 278.300(2) requires the Commission to render a decision regarding a utility's request to issue securities or to obtain financing within 60 days, unless it is necessary for good cause to continue the application for a longer time. As the Commission has not completed its investigation of this matter and has determined that additional time is required to thoroughly investigate the matter, the Commission finds that good cause exists to continue the financing application beyond the 60-day period specified in KRS 278.300(2).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the portion of Green River Valley's application for authorization to incur additional indebtedness is continued beyond the 60-day period as provided for and specified in KRS 278.300(2).
