Before the Commission is the September 15, 2009 Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule ("Motion") of the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky by and through his Office of Rate Intervention ("AG") seeking to modify the procedural schedule in this matter to permit him to file testimony or comments by October 16, 2009 and to allow Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc. ("Columbia") to file reply comments or rebuttal testimony by October 30, 2009.
