Ms. Eversole and Gentlemen:

Commission Staff wishes to clarify two points regarding the above-reference proceeding.

First, while the parties have agreed that Big Bear Wastewater Inc. should be permitted to assess a monthly rate of \$48.24 immediately for sewer service, the sewer utility may not place the agreed rate into effect until the Commission has approved the parties agreement and it may not assess the rate for service rendered prior to the Commission's approval.
