

Gentlemen:

As announced at the hearing you attended on February 3, 2009, the West Virginia Public Service Commission Staff ("PSC") was recommending "second tier" interim water rates to be implemented by the City of Kenova pending a final decision in this matter. The Interim Recommended Decision issued by the PSC on February 12, 2009, with the Approved Interim Rates, is attached. These rates will go into effect no later than March 4, 2009 and may go into effect earlier if the 15-day protest period is waived.

This interim rate for Kenova's resale customers, including Big Sandy, is \$1.79 per 1,000 gallons of water. Two surcharges are also added to the resale customer rate, one in the amount of 10¢ per thousand gallons and one in the amount of 4¢ per thousand gallons, to make up Kenova's arrearages to the Municipal Bond Commission and C.I. Thornburg. These surcharges, estimated to last 18 months, bring the total resale rate to \$1.93.

As you know, Kenova has tried very hard to keep Big Sandy's rates at the contracted-for rate of \$1.61. This would have been possible had Big Sandy agreed to a take-or-pay provision for the average amount of water Big Sandy had been purchasing for the past six months. I had offered to include a provision allowing the minimum amount to be renegotiated should Big Sandy's customer mix change. However, Big Sandy refused those efforts. As a result of information obtained by counsel for Ceredo about the status of the connection between Big Sandy and Ashland prior to the second hearing held on February 3, 2009, the case has been tolled for an additional 60 days and the second tier interim rates adopted.
