PETITION FOR APPROVAL TO DEVIATE FROM RULE

Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") petitions the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") to grant KU approval pursuant to 807 KAR 5:011 § 14, to deviate from the notice requirements in the above-captioned proceeding because KU has substantially complied with the Commission's notice regulations. In support of this petition, KU states as follows:

1. The purpose of the Commission's notice regulations is to ensure that the public has sufficient notice of KU's application and a meaningful opportunity to participate, individually or through representative agencies, in this proceeding. As stated by the Kentucky Supreme Court:

Substantial compliance in regard to publication requirements has been authorized. The purpose of the statute is to allow the public an ample opportunity to become sufficiently informed on the public question involved.¹

2. On June 26, 2009, KU filed its application asking the Commission to issue an order granting KU Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity for the construction of Selective Catalytic Reduction Nitrogen Oxides emission control technology at E.W. Brown Unit 3 and for the construction of new landfills at the Ghent and Trimble County Generating Stations,

and approving an amended compliance plan for purposes of recovering the costs of new pollution control facilities through its Environmental Surcharge tariff. Prior to filing its application, and in full compliance with all applicable notice regulations,² on June 11, 2009, KU delivered to the Kentucky Press Association a notice of the filing of its application for publication in 95 newspapers in KU's service areas, once a week for three consecutive weeks, with the first publication to begin the week of June 19, 2009.³

- 3. In an attempt to avoid notice publication shortfalls, in its most recent base rate case (Case No. 2008-00251),⁴ KU, the Office of the Attorney General, and the Commission's Executive Director wrote letters to all the newspapers in which KU's notice was to be published to impress upon the staffs of those newspapers the importance of timely publishing notices. (An illustrative copy of the KU letter is attached hereto as Exhibit A.) KU had hoped the letters would impact not only its rate case notice publications but also subsequent notice publications.
- 4. Notwithstanding these efforts, the following small local newspapers deviated from KU's requested publication. In reviewing these deviations, KU respectfully requests that the Commission consider that the two newspapers of largest circulation in the Commonwealth and in KU's service territory, the *Louisville Courier-Journal* and the *Lexington Herald-Leader*, timely published KU's notice on June 24, July 1, and July 8.
 - a. The *Carlisle Weekly* (circulation: 826), published in Bardwell, Kentucky, and covering Carlisle County, published KU's notice on July 1 and July 8, but failed to publish the notice scheduled for June 24 due to the ill health of the mother of the person responsible for placing such notices. KU scheduled an additional notice publication on

August 19 to complete the three-publication requirement, so that the notice ran in the *Carlisle Weekly* on July 1, July 8, and August 19.

Though the *Carlisle Weekly* failed to publish one of the three required times, the other paper published in Carlisle County, the *Carlisle County News* (circulation: 301), published KU's notice once each week for three consecutive weeks, on June 24, July 1, and July 8.

- b. The *Edmonson News*, published in Brownsville, Kentucky, and covering Edmonson County, published KU's notice on July 2 and July 9, but failed to publish the notice scheduled for June 25 due to the paper's having changed Internet service providers and having lost the notice copy in the process. KU scheduled an additional notice publication on August 20 to complete the three-publication requirement, so that the notice ran in the *Edmonson News* on July 2, July 9, and August 20.
- c. The *Boone County Recorder*, published in Fort Mitchell, Kentucky, and covering Boone County, published KU's notice on June 25 and July 9, but failed to publish the notice scheduled for July 2 because the paper erroneously published the notice on its website, not in its printed paper. KU scheduled an additional notice publication on August 20 to complete the three-publication requirement, so that the notice ran in the *Boone County Recorder* on June 25, July 9, and August 20.
- d. The *Glasgow Daily Times*, published in Glasgow, Kentucky, and covering Barren County, published KU's notice on June 22, but failed to publish the notices scheduled for June 29 and July 6 because the paper erroneously published two copies of the notice for KU's sister utility, Louisville Gas and Electric Company, rather than running each utility's notice. (The *Glasgow Daily Times* successfully ran both utilities'

notices on June 22.) KU scheduled two additional notice publications on August 19 and August 24 to complete the three-publication requirement, so that the notice ran in the *Glasgow Daily Times* on June 22, August 19, and August 24.

- e. The *Garrard Central Record*, published in Lancaster, Kentucky, and covering Garrard County, published KU's notice on July 2 and July 9, but failed to publish the notice scheduled for June 25 due to a clerical error. KU scheduled an additional notice publication on August 20 to complete the three-publication requirement, so that the notice ran in the *Garrard Central Record* on July 2, July 9, and August 20.
- f. The *Providence Journal Enterprise* (circulation: 4,364), published in Providence, Kentucky, and covering Webster County, published KU's notice on June 25 and July 9, but failed to publish the notice scheduled for July 2 due to a clerical error. KU scheduled an additional notice publication on August 20 to complete the three-publication requirement, so that the notice ran in the *Providence Journal Enterprise* on June 25, July 9, and August 20.

Though the *Providence Journal Enterprise* failed to publish one of the three scheduled times, the other paper published in Webster County, the *Sebree Banner* (circulation: 3,423), published KU's notice once each week for three consecutive weeks, on June 25, July 2, and July 9.

g. The *Interior Journal*, published in Stanford, Kentucky, and covering Lincoln County, published KU's notice on June 25 and July 2, but failed to publish the notice scheduled for July 9 due to having scheduled space for the notice, but having left the notice off of the printed page. KU scheduled an additional notice publication on

August 20 to complete the three-publication requirement, so that the notice ran in the *Interior Journal* on June 25, July 2, and August 20.

h. The *McCreary County Record* (circulation: 4,439), published in Whitley City, Kentucky, and covering McCreary County, published KU's notice on June 23 and June 30, but failed to publish the notice scheduled for July 7 due to a clerical error. KU scheduled an additional notice publication on August 18 to complete the three-publication requirement, so that the notice ran in the *McCreary County Record* on June 23, June 30, and August 18.

Though the *McCreary County Record* failed to publish one of the three scheduled times, the other paper published in McCreary County, the *McCreary County Voice* (circulation: 4,351), published KU's notice once each week for three consecutive weeks, on June 25, July 2, and July 9.

- 5. In addition to causing notice of the filing of its Application in this case to be published in newspapers of general circulation in its service areas, KU included an insert containing its notice in its customers' bills during the billing cycle that began on June 29, 2009. Because that billing cycle is now complete, every KU customer has received the notice as a bill insert.
- 6. Also, in compliance with 807 KAR 5:011 §8(2), on June 26, 2009, KU posted its notice for public inspection at its offices and places of business in the territory affected by the application.
- 7. As an additional means of giving notice, KU has posted on its website its Application in this proceeding.

- 8. In view of the fact that the great majority of the newspapers in KU's service territory—including the two newspapers of largest circulation in the Commonwealth and in KU's service territory, the *Louisville Courier-Journal* and the *Lexington Herald-Leader*—timely published all required notices, as well as KU's having included inserts of the notice in all of its customers' bills, KU respectfully requests a deviation from the Commission's notice regulations with respect to the instances of non-conformity cited above. Moreover, the paper of largest circulation published in each county has now published KU's notice three times each.
- 9. As noted at the beginning of this Petition, the Kentucky Supreme Court has stated, "Substantial compliance in regard to publication requirements has been authorized. The purpose of the statute is to allow the public an ample opportunity to become sufficiently informed on the public question involved." KU respectfully submits that it has substantially complied with the requirements of the Commission's notice regulations through its publication of the notice, bill inserts, and posting the notice in KU's offices and places of business. Also, the notice and Application is posted on KU's website. It is therefore clear that KU has achieved and is achieving the purpose of the Commission's applicable notice regulations, namely ensuring that the public has sufficient notice of KU's application and a meaningful opportunity to participate, individually or through representative agencies, in this proceeding. KU therefore respectfully requests the Commission to grant a deviation from its notice regulations, deeming KU's substantial compliance to be sufficient compliance with those regulations in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, Kentucky Utilities Company respectfully requests that, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:011 § 14, the Commission grant a deviation from its notice regulations, deeming KU's substantial compliance to be sufficient compliance with those regulations in this proceeding.

NOTICE TO CUSTOMERS OF KENTUCKY UTILITIES COMPANY

RECOVERY BY ENVIRONMENTAL SURCHARGE OF KENTUCKY UTILITIES COMPANY'S 2009 ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE PLAN

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on June 26, 2009, Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") will file with the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") in Case No. 2009-00197, an Application pursuant to Kentucky Revised Statute 278.183 for approval of an amended compliance plan ("KU's 2009 Environmental Compliance Plan") for the purpose of recovering the capital costs and operation and maintenance costs associated with new pollution control facilities through an environmental surcharge on customers' bills beginning February 2010, under KU's existing rate mechanism known as the environmental cost recovery surcharge or "Electric Rate Schedule ECR."

Federal, state and local environmental regulations require KU to continually build and upgrade equipment and facilities in order to operate in an environmentally sound manner. Specifically, KU is seeking Commission approval of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") to construct a new Selective Catalytic Reduction system ("SCR") for Brown Unit 3 at the E.W. Brown Generating Station in Burgin, Kentucky to comply with federally mandated nitrogen oxides requirements, and approval for CPCNs to construct new landfill facilities at the Ghent Generating Station in Ghent, Kentucky and at the Trimble County Generating Station near Wises Landing in Trimble County, Kentucky.. Additionally, KU is seeking recovery of costs associated with these environmental projects, which are necessary for compliance with the Federal Clean Air Act, the Federal Clean Water Act and the Federal Resource Conservation and Recovery Act. These additional projects primarily relate to installation of an SCR system on Brown Unit 3, expansion of the coal combustion byproduct ("CCP") treatment basin at the E.W. Brown Generation Station, expansion of the CCP treatment basins at the Trimble County Generating Station, construction of new landfill facilities at the Ghent and Trimble County generating stations, and certain operating costs associated with the Air Quality Control System equipment necessary to operate Trimble County Unit 2 within the approved environmental limitations. The capital cost of the new pollution control facilities for which KU is seeking recovery at this time is estimated to be \$463 million. Additional operation and maintenance expense will be incurred for these facilities.

The estimated impact on a residential customer using 1,000 kilowatt hours per month is expected to be an initial monthly increase of \$0.99 for KU customers during 2010, with the maximum monthly increase expected to be \$3.73 during 2013.

The Environmental Surcharge Application described in this Notice is proposed by KU. However, the Public Service Commission may issue an order modifying or denying KU's Environmental Surcharge Application. Such action may result in an environmental surcharge for consumers other than the environmental surcharge described in this Notice.

Any corporation, association, body politic or person may, by motion within thirty (30) days after publication, request leave to intervene in Case No. 2009-00197. That motion shall be submitted to the Public Service Commission, 211 Sower Blvd., P.O. Box 615, Frankfort, Kentucky, 40602, and shall set forth the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party. Intervenors may obtain copies of the Application and testimony by contacting Kentucky Utilities Company at 220 West Main Street, Louisville, Kentucky, 40202, Attention: Lonnie E. Bellar, Vice President, State Regulation and Rates. A copy of the Application and testimony will be available for public inspection at KU's offices where bills are paid after June 26, 2009.

RECOVERY BY ENVIRONMENTAL SURCHARGE OF KENTUCKY UTILITIES COMPANY'S 2009 ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE PLAN

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on June 26, 2009, Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") filed with the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") in Case No. 2009-00197, an Application pursuant to Kentucky Revised Statute 278.183 for approval of an amended compliance plan ("KU's 2009 Environmental Compliance Plan") for the purpose of recovering the capital costs and operation and maintenance costs associated with new pollution control facilities through an environmental surcharge on customers' bills beginning February 2010, under KU's existing rate mechanism known as the environmental cost recovery surcharge or "Electric Rate Schedule ECR."

Federal, state and local environmental regulations require KU to continually build and upgrade equipment and facilities in order to operate in an environmentally sound manner. Specifically, KU is seeking Commission approval of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") to construct a new Selective Catalytic Reduction system ("SCR") for Brown Unit 3 at the E.W. Brown Generating Station in Burgin, Kentucky to comply with federally mandated nitrogen oxides requirements, and approval for CPCNs to construct new landfill facilities at the Ghent Generating Station in Ghent, Kentucky and at the Trimble County Generating Station near Wises Landing in Trimble County, Kentucky.. Additionally, KU is seeking recovery of costs associated with these environmental projects, which are necessary for compliance with the Federal Clean Air Act, the Federal Clean Water Act and the Federal Resource Conservation and Recovery Act. These additional projects primarily relate to installation of an SCR system on Brown Unit 3, expansion of the coal combustion byproduct ("CCP") treatment basin at the E.W. Brown Generation Station, expansion of the CCP treatment basins at the Trimble County Generating Station, construction of new landfill facilities at the Ghent and Trimble County generating stations, and certain operating costs associated with the Air Quality Control System equipment necessary to operate Trimble County Unit 2 within the approved environmental limitations. The capital cost of the new pollution control facilities for which KU is seeking recovery at this time is estimated to be \$463 million. Additional operation and maintenance expense will be incurred for these facilities.

The estimated impact on a residential customer using 1,000 kilowatt hours per month is expected to be an initial monthly increase of \$0.99 for KU customers during 2010, with the maximum monthly increase expected to be \$3.73 during 2013.

The Environmental Surcharge Application described in this Notice is proposed by KU. However, the Public Service Commission may issue an order modifying or denying KU's Environmental Surcharge Application. Such action may result in an environmental surcharge for consumers other than the environmental surcharge described in this Notice.

Any corporation, association, body politic or person may, by motion within thirty (30) days after publication, request leave to intervene in Case No. 2009-00197. That motion shall be submitted to the Public Service Commission, 211 Sower Blvd., P.O. Box 615, Frankfort, Kentucky, 40602, and shall set forth the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party. Intervenors may obtain copies of the Application and testimony by contacting Kentucky Utilities Company at 220 West Main Street, Louisville, Kentucky, 40202, Attention: Lonnie E. Bellar, Vice President, State Regulation and Rates. A copy of the Application and testimony will be available for public inspection at KU's offices where bills are paid after June 26, 2009.
