Bullitt Utilities, Inc. hereby submits its Application to revise tariff language to include the below listed non-recurring charges for the sewer utility owned by Bullitt Utilities, Inc.. The non-recurring charge cost justifications for the following items and the proposed new Tariff have been enclosed as Attachments A and B, respectively.

- 1) Bad check fee;
- 2) Administrative and transportation fee where lawsuit filed;
- 3) Termination of service charge; and,
- 4) Reconnection of service charge.

Bullitt Utilities, Inc. is requesting the approval of the non-recurring charges, because the increased costs attributable to these non-recurring charges can not be absorbed by the Utility. The customers affected by these increases will be the customers that caused the Utility to incur these additional expenses. Bullitt Utilities, Inc. does not believe that the additional revenue generated from the proposed tariff revisions will exceed by five percent (5%) the total revenues provided by all miscellaneous and non-recurring charges for a recent twelve (12) month period.

The proposed revisions to the tariff could not have previously been made by Bullitt Utilities, Inc. because the issues have arisen since general economic conditions within the state have worsened. The Utility is currently experiencing more late payments and delinquencies due to the difficult economic conditions. The proposed revisions need to be made at this time so that only the customers causing the Utility to incur the increased expenses will pay for same, and these additional expenses will not cause harm to the other customers of the Utility or to the Utility.
