Dear Ms. Keyer:

On September 25, 2009, the Commission received New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC d/b/a AT&T Mobility's ("AT&T Mobility") Petition to treat as confidential its responses to Windstream Kentucky East, LLC's First Data Requests. AT&T Mobility seeks to have Item 9 and the attachment to Item 29 withheld from public inspection. In support of its Petition, AT&T Mobility states that the information contained within those responses are proprietary and confidential and would aid AT&T Mobility's competitors if released. AT&T Mobility states that the responses contain confidential business information obtained within an agreement with a toll provider for AT&T Mobility. AT&T Mobility states, among other arguments, that disclosure would adversely affect the carrier's ability to negotiate more favorable terms from other toll providers in the future. For these reasons, AT&T Mobility states that its responses are entitled to confidential treatment under KRS 61.878 *et seq.* and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7.

The Commission has determined that Item 9 and the attachment to Item 29, if disclosed, would cause competitive injury. This information satisfies the standard for confidential treatment under the law as enumerated herein, and, therefore, AT&T Mobility's request for confidentiality is **GRANTED**.
