JOINT MOTION TO CONTINUE BRIEFING SCHEDULE


The parties to this proceeding, South Shore Water Works Co. (“South Shore”) and the City of Greenup, Kentucky (“Greenup”), by and through counsel, jointly move to continue the briefing schedule set by the Commission in its order dated April 5, 2010. As grounds, the parties state that recent flooding has made it impossible for counsel for Greenup to access his office and files, necessitating a limited extension of time to complete initial briefing of the jurisdictional questions posed by the Commission. Specifically, the parties ask for the Commission to enter an order setting the following:

- (1) On or before May 12, 2010, South Shore and Greenup will file their initial written briefs addressing the questions posed by the Commission in its April 5, 2010 order; and
- (2) On or before May 27, 2010, South Shore and Greenup will file reply briefs.
