602 KAR 50:030

SECTION 1. THE COMMISSION HAS ZONING JURISDICTION OVER THAT AIRSPACE OVER AND AROUND THE PUBLIC-USE AIRPORTS AND MILITARY AIRPORTS WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH WHICH LIES ABOVE THE IMAGINARY SURFACE THAT EXTENDS OUTWARD AND UPWARD AT ONE OF THE FOLLOWING SLOPES:

(1) ONE HUNDRED (100) TO ONE (1) FOR A HORIZONTAL DISTANCE OF TWENTY THOUSAND (20,000) FEET FROM THE NEAREST POINT OF THE NEAREST RUNWAY OF EACH PUBLIC-USE AIRPORT OR MILITARY AIRPORT WITH AT LEAST ONE (1) RUNAWAY THREE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED (3,200) OR MORE FEET IN LENGTH; OR

(2) FIFTY (50) TO ONE (1) FOR A HORIZONTAL DISTANCE OF TEN THOUSAND (10,000) FEET FROM THE NEAREST POINT OF THE NEAREST RUNWAY OF EACH PUBLIC-USE AIRPORT OR MILITARY AIRPORT WITH ITS LONGEST RUNWAY LESS THAN THREE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED (3,200) FEET IN LENGTH.

SECTION 2. THE COMMISSION HAS ZONING JURISDICTION OVER THE USE OF LAND AND STRUCTURES WITHIN PUBLIC-USE AIRPORTS WITHIN THE STATE.

SECTION 3. THE COMMISSION HAS JURISDICTION FROM THE GROUND UPWARD WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE PRIMARY AND APPROACH SURFACES OF EACH PUBLIC-USE AIRPORT AND MILITARY AIRPORT AS DEPICTED ON AIRPORT ZONING MAPS APPROVED BY THE KENTUCKY AIRPORT ZONING COMMISSION.

SECTION 4. THE COMMISSION HAS JURISDICTION OVER THE AIRSPACE OF THE COMMONWEALTH THAT EXCEEDS TWO HUNDRED (200) FEET IN HEIGHT ABOVE GROUND LEVEL.

SECTION 5. THE OWNER OR PERSON WHO HAS CONTROL OVER A STRUCTURE WHICH PENETRATES OR WILL PENETRATE THE AIRSPACE OVER WHICH THE COMMISSION HAS JURISDICTION SHALL APPLY FOR A PERMIT FROM THE COMMISSION IN ACCORDANCE WITH 602 KAR 50:090.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. "ALTERATION" MEANS TO INCREASE OR DECREASE THE HEIGHT OF A STRUCTURE OR CHANGE THE OBSTRUCTION MARKING AND LIGHTING.

2. "APPLICANT" MEANS THE PERSON WHO WILL OWN OR HAVE CONTROL OVER THE COMPLETED STRUCTURE.

3. "CERTIFICATION BY APPLICANT" SHALL BE MADE BY THE INDIVIDUAL WHO WILL OWN OR CONTROL THE COMPLETED STRUCTURE; OR A PARTNER IN A PARTNERSHIP; OR THE PRESIDENT OR AUTHORIZED OFFICER OF A CORPORATION, COMPANY OR ASSOCIATION; OR THE AUTHORIZED OFFICIAL OF A BODY POLITIC; OR THE LEGALLY DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE OF A TRUSTEE, RECEIVER OR ASSIGNEE.

4. PREPARE THE APPLICATION AND FORWARD TO THE ADMINISTRATOR, KENTUCKY AIRPORT ZONING COMMISSION, DEPARTMENT OF AVIATION, 200 MERO STREET, FRANKFORT, KY 40622. FOR QUESTIONS, TELEPHONE 502-564-4480.

5. THE STATUTES APPLICABLE TO THE KENTUCKY AIRPORT COMMISSION ARE KRS 183.861 TO 183.990 AND THE ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS ARE 602 KAR CHAPTER 50.






