INTERROGATORY No. 4: To your knowledge, who constructed the Private Water Line, how much did it cost and who paid for such construction?

ANSWER: To my knowledge the 3" water line was constructed by Peewee Robinson, a contractor hired by the former property owner, Clarence Davis. I have no knowledge as to the cost of the water line, or who paid for the construction.

INTERROGATORY No. 5: When the Private Water Line was constructed, where was the Original Water Meter located?

ANSWER: The original water meter was located on Mr. Congleton's property on Highway 421 in Henry County.

INTERROGATORY No. 6: When the Private Water Line was constructed who purchased the Original Water Meter, who paid the Tap-on Fee, and what did each cost?

ANSWER: The original purchase and payment was by Ray Powell. The total fee paid was \$350.00.

INTERROGATORY No. 7: To your knowledge, did Larry Congleton give permission to allow the Private Water Line, with the Original Water Meter, to be constructed on his property and used for water delivery to the Wayne Farm from 1997 through 2007? If your answer is anything other than Yes, please explain. Please provide all documentation of your answer.

ANSWER: Yes. See, Attachment 1: Account history summaries for June 1997 through August 2000 showing active service for Ray Powell/Clarence Davis and

account history summary for September 2000, which is the beginning month for Complainant's active service.

INTERROGATORY No. 8: Do you agree that a private water line to access a municipal or public water spply is an improvement to real property, in the nature of a fixture, and that it passes with the real property to subsequent purchasers of that real property? If your answer is No, please explain your answer with the legal basis and authority you rely upon.

ANSWER: OBJECTION. The answer to this question requires a legal opinion as to whether a water line is a fixture that can be conveyed by deed. Furthermore, pursuant to 400 KAR 1:040, undersigned counsel submits that the interrogatory should not be required to be answered until after designated discovery has been fully completed, particularly in regard to the Complainant's basis for asserting the water line was conveyed to him by the prior owner.

INTERROGATORY No. 9: Did you ever take any action to assert ownership of the Private Water Line from the time it was constructed and in service in 1997 through 2007, and before a leak was discovered in the Private Water Line? If you did, please provide complete details of such action and provide all documentation.

ANSWER: No.

INTERROGATORY No. 10: Were you aware that when Wayne discovered a water leak in the Private Water Line in early 2008, that he [or his farm manager] sought access to fix the leak on the Larry Congleton property but such access was refused and that Mr. Congleton made threatening statements to the far manager of the Wayne Farm? Do you

dispute the truth of this statement? If you were aware of this refusal, what steps, if any did you take to stop the water leak?

ANSWER: I was made aware that Mr. Congleton refused Mr. Wayne's contractor access to the property, but I have no knowledge of any threatening statements. I have no personal knowledge of any conversations between Mr. Wayne, Mr. Congleton and/or Mr. Wayne's farm manager. I cannot confirm or deny the truth of the statements made. The meter was checked to confirm reading and the meter service line to the meter was visually checked for any leaks. No leaks were found on Henry District's side of the meter. No repairs were made by Henry District on Congleton's side of the meter until after the Henry District obtained an easement and took over the line.

INTERROGATORY No. 11: Were you aware that when Wayne was denied access to the Larry Congleton property to fix the leak in the Private Water Line, that he (through his farm manager) turned the water off at the Original Water Meter to stop the leak, and Wayne then contacted the Water District to request that service be discontinued until the leak could be fixed? Do you dispute the truth of this statement?

ANSWER: I am aware that Mr. Wayne contacted the water district to have service discontinued because he could not get the leak repaired. I was made aware that Mr. Congleton refused Mr. Wayne's contractor access to the property. I have no knowledge as to what actions taken by his farm manager.

INTERROGATORY No. 12: When did the Water District first take action to assert control over and ownership of the Private Water Line? What action(s) was/were taken? Provide all documentation of such action.

ANSWER: After Mr. Wayne discontinued service, Mr. Congleton requested the service in his name in March 2008 and subsequently offered an easement to the Henry District. On July 23, 2008 a letter was sent to Mr. Wayne telling him that Mr. Congleton had made an easement offer to District for the 3" water line. The easement was obtained in September 2008.

INTERROGATORY No. 13: What did the Water District pay for the Private Water Line and when and to whom was such sum paid?

ANSWER: The Henry District did not pay any amounts for the easement. The water line was existing.

INTERROGATORY No. 14: Does the Water District claim it has the right to take ownership of a Private Water Line that it never paid for, without the prior consent of the person who paid for that construction (here Davis), or the person who purchased such improvement to realty (here Wayne)? If the Water District claims it has such right or authority, please provide the legal and factual basis for such claim.

ANSWER: The Henry District proceeded through its normal course of business. The Henry District was granted an easement by the property owner on which the 3" water line is physically located. See: Attachment 2- Letter to Jim Wayne with attached statement from Clarence Davis; Attachment 3- Letter to Jim Wayne dated November 19, 2008; and, Attachment 4- Recorded Right of Way easement for #3 water line on Congleton property.

INTERROGATORY No. 15: Please explain why the action of the Water District to take control and ownership of the Private Water Line to the Wayne Farm without paying for it and without the consent of Wayne, as owner of the Wayne Farm is not a "taking" of

property without just compensation. Provide the complete legal and factual basis for your answer. Provide all documents the you rely upon in your answer.

ANSWER: See Answer to Interrogatory No. 15 above.

INTERROGATORY No. 16: Will you agree to supplement these answers as you learn or discover new relevant facts and documents that are responsive to these interrogatories?

ANSWER: Yes.

Dear Mr. Wayne:

Enclosed is a signed statement from Mr. Clarence Davis detailing the circumstances of how water service was supplied to his property. This is the same property that you purchased from Mr. Davis.

From our previous conversations, it is still the desire of the Henry County Water District #2 to incorporate the water line in question into our system. This would allow other residents on McCarty Lane access to safe drinking water. This falls under former Governor Patton's plan to provide all Kentuckians access to safe drinking water by 2020. Upon approval from the Division of Water, the District would incorporate the water line into its system and maintain the line. The District would re-locate your meter to your property or terminate the line at your property if that is what you choose.

Larry Congleton has agreed to give the District an easement for the water line plus any service lines to other residents on McCarty Lane as it was intended when this line was installed. Initially, the line is located on the Congleton farm and he appears to have the right to execute an easement in favor of the District. Any dispute that you have concerning this should be addressed with Mr. Congleton.

The following statement below is a true and accurate account of how water service came about on my farm on McCarty Lane in the year of 1997.

The meter was set in May 1997 in the name of Mr. Ray Powell. Shortly thereafter the account was transferred into the name of Mr. Clarence Davis. The meter was installed onto property owned by Mr. Larry Congleton. An unwritten agreement took place between Mr. Davis and Mr. Congleton giving permission to Mr. Davis to install a 3" water line from the meter through Mr. Congleton's property to Mr. Davis' property.

After the line was installed Mr. Davis and Mr. Congleton contacted Mr. Gene Powell, who was Superintendent of the Henry County Water District #2, about the District taking over the 3" line allowing other residents on McCarty Lane water service. Mr. Congleton agreed to sign an easement over to the District on the water line.

Mr. Powell agreed to take over the water line on behalf of the District once the District came off of the tap-on ban imposed by The Division of Water. Mr. Powell retired from the District shortly thereafter before an easement was signed.

As stated before, this is a true and accurate account of verbal agreements between all parties involved.




