## ORDER

The Kentucky Rural Water Association ("KRWA") has applied for accreditation of its 2009 Annual Technical Conference and Exhibition to be held August 24-26 in Lexington, Kentucky.

Pursuant to KRS 74.020(7), this Commission is required to "encourage and promote the offering of high-quality water district management training programs that enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her duties." The course of instruction for which approval is sought includes presentations regarding, <u>inter alia</u>, water and wastewater regulations, electronic data management and transfer, public relations, purchasing practices, supervisory control and data systems, and methods for reduction of energy usage. Having reviewed KRWA's application describing the proposed course, the Commission finds that the proposed course will enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties and should be approved for 12.0 credit hours for water district management training.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. KRWA's proposed course of instruction is hereby approved for a maximum of 12.0 credit hours of water district management training.

2. KRWA shall retain a record of all persons attending the approved course of instruction.

3. Within 14 days of the completion of the conference, KRWA shall file with the Commission a sworn statement attesting that the approved course of instruction was performed and, if any changes in the speakers or course curriculum occurred after KRWA's application, a description of those changes.
