In a session held on June 14, 2009, the City Council of Mackville, Kentucky passed Ordinance No. 001-09, which directed the advertising for bids and selling of an electric franchise in Mackville.

For many years, the Company has been the owner of separate franchises ranted by the Cities to erect facilities for providing electric service to the Cities and the Mr. Jeff DeRouen September 2, 2009

inhabitants thereof. The franchise to be obtained will replace the current franchises.
