I am writing in regards to a "Public Notice" letter that I received from Lawyers "Dinsmore and Shoh LLP" The letter was about a "Bluegrass Cellular " tower which they want to locate on Stringtown RD, Morgantown, Ky. 42261. In the letter it states that I have the right to intervene in this matter. But, it doesn't state exactly what my rights are or what risk to the value of my property. This tower is to be built across the road from my land but the 500 feet radius is well within my property line. I would like to know exactly what my rights are regarding this matter. Seems to me with the tower being so close to and well within 500 feet of the tower someone from the Bluegrass Cellular would have talked directly to me about their plans. It has all been kept quiet from me except for the registered letter from "Lawyers"

This is going to be a huge tower. I would like to know if there are any health risk or de-valuing of my property or any other information I can obtain. I would like to know before the tower is built. I think this is a fair thing to expect from Bluegrass Cellular sense the 500 feet radius is well over my property line. Looking at the map from the lawyers letter I think the radius of the tower is 300 to 400 feet across my property line. I would think this will effect my property. Almost as much as the land owners rights that the tower will be sitting on.

Our daughters may someday want to build a house on our property and the locations at least one of them I believe will be within the 500 ft radius of the tower. I don't think anyone would want to build a house under a tower that huge. I think the tower being built will effect their decision of building a home on our property.

If there is any way that I can receive information from the Public Service Commission of Kentucky I would greatly appreciate. If not can you tell me where I can find out exactly what my rights are before construction of the tower begins. This seems fair in my opinion.

Thank you for any help you can give me regarding this matter. I appreciate you taking time to read my concerns about the tower being built in this locatiom.
