RE: Kentucky Power Company Case No. 2009-00459 Filing Deficiencies

The Commission staff has conducted a further review of Kentucky Power Company's application in the above case. In addition to the deficiency noted by letter dated January 7, 2010, the filing is rejected for the additional reasons set forth below:

Filing deficiencies pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001:

- (1) Section 10 (3)(b) The present and proposed rates for each customer class to which the proposed rates would apply.
  - A. The customer notice (Vol. 1, Section II, Exh. A, Page 34) states that Tariff N.M.S. has an application fee of \$50, whereas the proposed tariff sheet provides no fee for Level 1 and a \$100 fee for Level 2.

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B. The customer notice includes no disclosure of a change in Tariffs R. S., R.S.-L.M.-T.O.D., and R.S.-T.O.D. to make the five percent delayed payment charge applicable to accounts not paid by the bill due date, rather than by the next billing date, whereas the proposed tariff sheet includes that change.

The statutory time period in which the Commission must process this case will not commence until the above-mentioned information is filed with the Commission. If your filing contains a proposed effective date, the rejection of your filing for reasons of deficiencies voids the proposed effective date. When you file the required information to correct the deficiencies you may refile your proposed tariff with a new proposed effective date that is at least 30 days from the date you file the required information. You are requested to file 10 copies of this information within 15 days of date of this letter.
