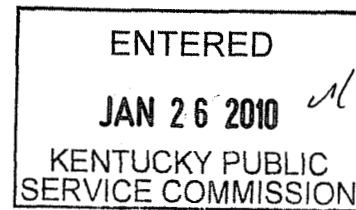
O R D E R

On December 7, 2009, Mark R. Overstreet, an attorney licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth of Kentucky who is representing Kentucky Power Company ("Kentucky Power"), moved the Commission to admit pro hac vice Steven T. 
