## JOINT MOTION OF ATTORNEY GENERAL OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, OFFICE OF RATE INTERVENTION AND KENTUCKY POWER COMPANY'S PETITION FOR CONFIDENTIAL TREATMENT FOR DECISION ON THE EXISTING RECORD AND WITHOUT HEARING

The Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Office of Rate Intervention, and Kentucky Power Company for their "Joint Motion To Submit Kentucky Power Company's Petition For Confidential Treatment For Decision On The Record And Without Hearing" state:

- 1. Presently pending before the Public Service Commission of Kentucky is

  Kentucky Power's petition for confidential treatment of its responses to Nos. 47 and 51 of the

  Attorney General's First Set of Data Requests (the "Data Request Responses.")
- 2. The Attorney General objected to Kentucky Power's Petition for Confidential
  Treatment of the Data Request Responses, and further moved the Commission to conduct a
  hearing where he could cross-examine Rene Hawkins, who submitted an affidavit in support of
  Kentucky Power's Petition for Confidential Treatment.
- 3. Kentucky Power and the Attorney General have reached an agreement with respect to the Attorney General's motion to conduct a hearing. As part of the agreement, the Attorney General withdraws his motion to conduct a hearing. Further, both the Attorney General and Kentucky Power request that Kentucky Power's petition for confidential treatment of the

Data Request Responses be submitted for decision by the Commission on the existing record and without hearing.

4. The agreement by the Attorney General to withdraw his motion for a hearing and to have Kentucky Power's petition for confidential treatment of the Data Request Responses submitted for decision is not an admission and is without prejudice to the Attorney General's right to raise similar arguments in this and other proceedings.

Wherefore, Kentucky Power Company and the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Office of Rate Intervention, respectfully request that Kentucky Power's petition for confidential treatment of the Data Request Responses be submitted to the Commission for decision on the existing record and without hearing.
