ORDER

On December 1, 2009, the Commission suspended for five months the City of Whitesburg's ("Whitesburg") proposed adjustment to its existing wholesale water service rate to Letcher County Water and Sewer District and initiated an investigation into the reasonableness of the proposed rate. On August 6, 2010, we issued an Order stating our concern as to whether Whitesburg has met its burden of demonstrating the reasonableness of its proposed wholesale rate, scheduling an informal conference for Commission Staff to discuss this issue with Whitesburg, and setting an evidentiary hearing.

On August 16, 2010, Whitesburg filed a Motion to withdraw its rate case because it has been unable to produce appropriate documentation to justify the reasonableness of the proposed rate. Finding that Whitesburg should be permitted to withdraw its request for wholesale rate adjustment, IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Whitesburg's Motion to Withdraw Proposed Rate Adjustment is granted.
- 2. The hearing previously set for August 19, 2010 is cancelled.
- 3. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
