MOTION TO WITHDRAW APPLICATION OF EAST KENTUCKY POWER COOPERATIVE, INC. FOR APPROVAL OF THE ISSUANCE OF \$900,000,000 OF SECURED PRIVATE PLACEMENT DEBT AND UP TO \$21,435,000 OF UNSECURED DEBT

Comes now East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. ("EKPC"), by counsel, and for its Motion to the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") requesting that the Commission allow EKPC to Withdraw its Application for Approval of the Issuance of \$900,000,000 of Secured Private Placement Debt and Up to \$21,435,000 of Unsecured Debt, respectfully states as follows:

1. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8(1), the facts upon which EKPC's original Application was based are as follows: EKPC sought approval of the issuance of \$900,000,000 of secured private placement debt and up to \$21,435,000 of unsecured debt to finance Smith Unit No. 1 ("Smith 1 CFB"), a 278-megawatt coal-fired circulating fluidized bed generating unit. The Commission granted EKPC a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") for Smith 1 CFB in Case No. 2005-00053. After Warren Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation decided to decline membership from EKPC, the Commission reviewed the CPCN for Smith 1

CFB and ordered, in Case No. 2006-00564, that EKPC should retain said CPCN for Smith 1 CFB and continue construction.

- 2. Due to the need to provide permanent long-term financing for the construction of Smith 1 CFB, EKPC's Application in this case sought regulatory authority for the placement of the requested debt with capital markets lenders/investors. The Application set forth that the financing was to be funded in tranches and it was intended that the Commission would be informed at the time that each tranche was needed.
- 3. Proceeds from this financing was to be used to reimburse EKPC's general funds for Smith 1 CFB expenditures to date, possible new or unanticipated Smith 1 CFB costs (which should be minimal), as well as to directly fund yet-to-be incurred capital expenditures. Because of the structure of this financing, the terms of each placement were to vary by amount, tenor, and interest rate depending upon market conditions and lender expectations at the time of issuance.
- 4. EKPC's assertions made in paragraphs 1-12 of its original Application filed December 4, 2009, including the exhibits attached thereto, remain true and accurate to the best of its belief.
- 5. EKPC believes that financial prudency requires that it step back and reassess its immediate needs for this financing. EKPC will refile an Application under KRS 278.300 for Commission approval pending this reassessment

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, EKPC respectfully requests that the Commission grant its Motion to Withdraw the Application and enter an Order dismissing same, without prejudice.
