Question No. 1

Witness: Robert M. Conroy

- Q-1. Refer to the Company's Response to Item 5.
 - a. Explain the modifications to the Ghent gypsum stack referenced in the fourth paragraph of the response.
 - b. Provide the consumables included in Account 506109 referenced in the fifth paragraph of the response.
- A-1. a. The Ghent gypsum stack modifications included earthwork to build up gypsum berms and upgrades to the drainage system. KU retained the design engineer, STANTEC (formerly known as FMSM) to evaluate the gypsum stack including the performance of the existing drainage system and the overall operation of the stack. STANTEC determined the drainage system was not performing as designed and recommended modifications to include supplemental drainage. The drainage work will control the elevation of the water within the stacked gypsum which is expected to help maintain safety factors in accordance with regulatory and industry guidelines.
 - b. The consumables purchased and utilized for SO3 Mitigation at the Ghent Station are Hydrated Lime and Trona. Both products were tested to see which one provides the optimal performance for the units. Ghent Units 3 and 4 use Trona and Ghent Unit 1 uses a blend of hydrated lime and Trona.

3	Q.	What is the bill impact on a residential customer for the proposed collection of
4		the under-recovery?
5	A.	KU is proposing to collect the under-recovery of \$3,705,904 over a six month period.
6		The inclusion of \$617,651 per month in the determination of the ECR billing factor
7		will increase the billing factor by approximately 0.70%. For a residential customer
8		using 1,000 kWh the ECR billing factor will increase by approximately \$0.45 per
9		month for six months (using rates and adjustment clause factors in effect for the
10		January 2010 billing month).
11	Q.	What rate of return is KU proposing to use for all ECR Plans upon the
12		Commission's Order in this proceeding?
13	A.	KU is recommending an overall rate of return on capital of 11.12%, including the
14		currently approved 10.63% return on equity and adjusted capitalization, to be used to
15		calculate the environmental surcharge. This is based on capitalization as of August
16		31, 2009 and the Settlement Agreement approved by the Commission in its February
17		5, 2009 Order in Case No. 2008-00251.
18	Q.	What is your recommendation to the Commission in this case?
19	A.	KU makes the following recommendations to the Commission in this case:
20		a) The Commission should approve the proposed increase to the Environmental
21		Surcharge Revenue Requirement of \$617,651 per month for the first four
22		months and \$617,650 per month for the following two months beginning in
