Dear Public Service Commission; **RE: Case #2009-00548**

WE THE PEOPLE request that you deny any and all electric rate increases that KU/LG&E/E.On has requested. **WE THE PEOPLE** protest their request on the grounds that they are not currently entitled because of the following factual reasons.

1. TC-2 is not needed now or in the foreseeable future. By KU's own admission their industrial sales are down 15%. Their 2008 IRP shows a 1.9% decrease in projected sales. Therefore TC-2 needs to be re-visited and put on hold until such time it is actually needed.
2. The fact that you (the Commission) have approved the building of an un-needed 42 mile transmission line to support the un-needed TC-2 is apprehensible.
3. The fact that you (the Commission) have approved the building of a 10 million dollar temporary transmission line to allow KU to circumvent legal challenges is just down right negligent.
4. If KU does prevail in the legal challenge you (the Commission) have given them the green light to tear down the temporary Transmission line and rebuild a permanent one at a cost of another 10 million dollars. This is 20 million dollars of wasted rate payers' money. You (the Commission) should be ashamed of the way you are allowing rate payers money to be wasted.

5. TC-2 is a dirty coal fired polluting power plant and has yet to get its air quality permit. Until it does get this permit it will not operate; therefore the public should not be forced to pay for a non-operational un-needed plant because of regulatory negligence by you (the Commission).
6. Because E.On is a GREEDY foreign power broker **WE THE PEOPLE** of the Commonwealth should not be forced to finance their GREED. We should not have to pay higher rates when none of the above is needed and we should not have to give up our precious land so this Power Broker can make billions upon billions of dollars from the forceful taking of our properties while **WE THE PEOPLE** foot the bill.
7. By KU's own admission "since April 1, 2009, 250,000 customers have requested to pay their bills through installments plans: however, approximately 58 percent of those have defaulted on those agreements." Do you (the Commission) think this will actually improve with increased rates?
8. E.On emphasizes the role of energy efficiency as a way for consumer to offset their energy consumption. What they fail to mention is that no amount of energy efficiency will offset the GREED of E.ON.

WE THE POPLE are demanding to be represented. If you (the Commission) refuse to represent us and alleviate our financial burdens then we will turn to the Attorney Generals office. If the Attorney General refuses to alleviate our financial burdens then **WE THE PEOPLE** will have no recourse except to stop paying our electric and gas bills issued by KU/LG&E/E.ON on the grounds that we will be unable to afford to pay them. How long will it take for them to shut down the power and gas to the overwhelming number of conscientious objecting consumers who are struggling in this recession? How long before E.On would be begging us to start paying our bills and even paying us "**WE THE PEOPLE**" to reconnect to their electric and gas lines. How long will it take before they cry UNCLE? **WE THE PEOPLE** are willing to find out! Is the Commonwealth willing to do the same because of you (the Commissions) negligence?
