The Natural Gas Utility Industry continues to face a difficult operating environment. A weak global economy and a tough regulatory climate have been the primary factors weighing on this sector. These companies continue to work to develop new opportunities to increase their profitability. However, for now, near-term prospects appear to be widely limited.

A Weak Economy

The macroeconomic climate continues to pressure this group. The dormant construction sector, reduced industrial demand, and unfavorable gas prices have hurt results in recent months. Weakness in the housing market has also weighed on demand in this industry. Indeed, new customer growth has been uninspiring of late. And existing customers are increasingly focusing on conservation, further dampening this sector's performance. Moreover, bill collection will likely continue to be challenging due to weak household income. Note, though, that this difficult stretch may make for easier year-over-year comparisons.

By and large, this industry tends to perform well when financial markets are turbulent. The recent volatility may well make less risky, dividend-paying businesses such as these utilities more attractive. Accordingly, we would keep an eye on this group in the months ahead.

Regulatory Environment

The most important factor for natural gas utilities remains the regulatory environment. The status of rate cases, which is dictated by state commissions and determines the return on equity these companies can earn, is closely watched. Rate cases generally occur when operational costs begin to pressure profitability. When rates are in order, these utilities generally post limited, though consistent, growth year to year. A new rate case that is viewed favorably can have a notable impact on a company's stock valuation. However, regulators also try to be cognizant of customers' interests by keeping prices fair. Note that the recent decline in natural gas prices augurs well for utilities seeking rate relief. All told, prospective investors should look out for stocks in the following pages that have cases pending since any decision could impact their performance.

Other Operating Factors

The managements of these companies routinely use a variety of strategies to improve results. Cost cutting has been a popular tactic in recent months as demand for natural gas has waned. Another strategy that is common is developing nonregulated ventures. These operations provide more upside (and are also more risky) than regulated operations since they are not restrained by state commissions. Further, these businesses provide a way for utilities to diversify their revenue base. Consolidation has been another option these companies have pursued to grow their business.


Unseasonable conditions can create volatility for these utilities, which can wreak havoc on the steady growth these businesses generally exhibit. In response, many companies use weather-adjusted rate mechanisms to stabilize results when there is unseasonable weather. Accordingly, conservative investors may want to consider companies that use such hedges.

Conclusion

The Natural Gas Utility Industry is ranked in the bottom half of our Industry spectrum. This group has lagged the market in recent months. Moreover, these companies have not registered particularly impressive top- and bottom-line results of late. Looking further, weexpect this group to remain under pressure in the months ahead due to unfavorable gas prices and the weakness in the global economy. However, if the economic recovery falters, these stocks may again come into favor as defensive plays, given their steady cash flow and reliable businesses.

The primary appeal of this sector is its above-average dividend yield. The average yield for this sector is about 4.6%, more than double the Value Line median of 2.1%. All told, we suggest conservative, income-oriented investors take a look here.
