- 8. That I also cashed in all of my IRA's and my retirement account back in May of this year and I also put those funds into Elam Utility Company in order to try to sustain the company and to try to prevent me from losing the company as I ended up doing;
- That I have <u>NOTHING</u>, no money, no property, no credit, no nothing, that I could use to pay the civil penalties assessed against me personally;
- That I have consulted with an attorney, namely Honorable Malenda Haynes, regarding the filing of bankruptcy, for both me personally and the business;
- 11. That I do not know if it is even possible for me to file bankruptcy on the civil penalties imposed against me personally by the Order of the Public
