We received a notice (copy included) that Hillridge Facilities, Inc. has filed an application with the Public Service Commission asking for a sewer rate increase. We strongly disagree with the need for this increase. All these years, Hillridge Facilities has been collecting these sewage fees, yet not repairing and keeping the sewage system station updated. Now they want a rate increase to upgrade and modernize the facility so they can sell it or merge with another system. If there had been timely and consistent repairs made all along, we would not be in this situation.

I hope you will take a hard look at this rate increase and hopefully deny it, or at least cut the increase drastically.

NOTICE

Hillridge Facilities, Inc. has filed an application with the Public Service Commission proposing to increase its monthly sewer rate from \$24.13 to \$32.50, an increase of 34.7%. Hillridge believes it could justify a rate increase of 55.6% based upon its operating costs, but has requested the much lower increase to reduce the burden upon its customers. Hillridge is also proposing to begin charging a surcharge of \$11.19 per month for 36 months to pay for sewer line repairs and replacements mandated by the Kentucky Division of Water. The proposed effective date of the change is November 29, 2010.

Upon request from an intervenor, the utility shall furnish to the intervenor a copy of the application and supporting documents.
