ORDER

Finding that further proceedings are necessary to investigate the reasonableness of the proposed rates and that a procedural schedule should be established to provide for the orderly review of the application of Water Service Corporation of Kentucky ("Water Service"), the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that:

- 1. The procedural schedule set forth in the Appendix to this Order shall be followed.
- 2. a. Responses to requests for information shall be appropriately bound, tabbed and indexed and shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided.
- b. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation, a partnership, an association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

- c. Any party shall make timely amendment to any prior response if it obtains information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect.
- d. For any request to which a party fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, that party shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.
- 3. When Water Service is required in this proceeding to provide notice of an event or filing pursuant to statute or administrative regulation, it shall forward a duplicate of the notice and request to the Commission when requesting publication.
- 4. Water Service shall publish notice of the scheduled hearing in this matter in accordance with 807 KAR 5:011, Section 8(5), and shall file proof of publication with the Commission no later than July 11, 2011.
- 5. At any hearing in this matter, neither opening statements, summarization of direct testimony or rebuttal testimony shall be permitted.
- 6. Motions for extensions of time with respect to the schedule herein shall be made in writing and will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.
- 7. Pursuant to KRS 278.360, the record of the formal hearing in this matter shall be by videotape.
- 8. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering further Orders in this matter.
