Now, if there is a problem it is impossible to talk with anyone at the water service without waiting for twenty minutes to talk with a live person.

The economy is this area is not able to support continued rate increases for these utility companies which have a MONOPOLY on services—there is no other water service provider in this area—so the residents are compelled to receive water service from WSCK. A request for any amount is unreasonable but to request a 21.9% increase is just RIDUCLOUS. I am sure the water company has expenses, however so do their customers.

Please do not allow any rate increase to WSCK.
