

Dear Mr. Derouen:

In regard to the above-captioned complaints, counsel for BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a AT&T Kentucky has requested, and counsel for the Defendants have no objection to, an extension of time until April 9, 2010, to file answers to the Defendants' Counterclaims and responses to the Motions to Dismiss. Therefore, AT&T Kentucky, without objection by Defendants, requests an extension of time, if needed, to that date for the filing of responsive pleadings.

The reason for this request is that companion cases are pending among many, if not all, of these Parties in one or more of the other eight states of the former BellSouth region. Counsel for AT&T Kentucky and attorneys for the Defendants have discussed – and are continuing to discuss in good faith – the possibility of jointly submitting a proposed procedural schedule that will advance the proceedings while avoiding conflicting obligations among the states.
