In that capacity, we are responding to your letter dated March 15, 2010, addressed to the Public Service Commission of the Commonwealth of Kentucky (the "Commission") regarding your concerns with respect to the proposed construction of a cell tower facility to be located at 5210 Highway 1157, Lebanon, Kentucky, 40033.

Kentucky RSA #4 has directed this law firm to inform you that it has, at this time, decided not to go any further in the approval process of its application for the proposed Bradfordsville cell site, at its current location.

Kentucky RSA #4 is researching its options for an alternate location for the Bradfordsville cell site. This process is extensive and may take up to 60 days, or longer, to find another viable and suitable location.
