The parties discussed next week's hearing. Mr. Conn stated that he and his wife would testify as to general background information related to their complaint. He also stated that Scott Wilburn, who is the supervisor of the Maxey Flats site and works with the Kentucky Division of Waste Management, will testify as to the ownership of the water line and sampling data from the area. Jerry Ferguson, a friend of the Conns, will also testify as to the water lines in the area.
