Mr. Brent:

The Public Service Commission has received the Confidentiality Petition you filed on August 17, 2010 on behalf of Sprint Spectrum, L.P., Nextel West Corp., NPCR, Inc. and Sprint Communications Company, L.P. ("Sprint"). Sprint seeks to protect **Exhibit RGF-4 of the Rebuttal Testimony of Randy G. Farrar** as confidential under Section 7 of 807 KAR 5:001 and KRS 61.878, *et seq*.

Sprint alleges that these documents contain confidential and proprietary information on traffic volumes originated by AT&T Mobility and transited by AT&T to Sprint. Sprint contends that if this information were made public the details would aid its competitors and competitors to AT&T and could be used to disadvantage and create significant and irreparable harm to each company.

The Commission has carefully analyzed the information contained within **Exhibit RGF-4** of the Rebuttal Testimony of Randy G. Farrar and has determined that the information contained therein, if disclosed, would cause competitive injury. For these reasons, the Commission finds that this information satisfies the standard for protection under KRS 61.878(1)(c)(1), KRS 61.878(1)(m)(1)(f) and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7, and, therefore, those portions of the request for confidentiality are **GRANTED**.

As this information that has been **GRANTED** protection, the Commission will withhold the protected information contained in the current Petition from public inspection. If the information that has been granted protection becomes publicly available or no longer warrants confidential treatment, you are required by 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7(9)(a), to inform the Commission so that the information may be placed in the public record.
