The utilities and Commission Staff discussed the applications filed by the utilities and the data requests dated March 29, 2010. The utilities sought clarification of some of the questions asked by Staff. After discussion and suggestions by Staff as to what should be addressed in the responses, the utilities indicated that they would make the necessary adjustments to the language of the tariff proposals and their form and submit those with their responses to the data requests. The utilities also indicated that they would supplement any response (i.e., the bid sheets for the excavation work) that was not completed by the due date for responses as soon thereafter as possible.
