The Public Service Commission has received the Petition for Confidential Protection you filed on March 8, 2010 on behalf of Louisville Gas & Electric ("LG&E"), to protect certain information filed with the Commission as confidential pursuant to Section 7 of 807 KAR 5:001 and KRS 61.878. The information you seek to have treated as confidential is identified as information contained in supporting documents to LG&E's Answer to the Meyer Complaint. The information is more particularly described as copies of Complainant's brown bills, which contain customer's account number.

Your justification for having the Commission handle this material as confidential, is of a personal nature and that the public disclosure of the information would result in an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.
