NOTICE

Irvine Municipal Utilities has filed a proposed rate schedule which will increase, by 2.7 percent, the rate(s) which it currently charges to Estill County Water and Sewer District for water service. Irvine Municipal Utilities currently charges Estill County Water and Sewer District \$2.164 per 1,000 gallons of water service. It proposes to charge Estill County Water and Sewer District \$2.222 per 1,000 gallons for water service effective April 16, 2010. The rates listed exclude the \$0.12 Kentucky River Authority Assessment per 1,000 gallons sold.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by Irvine Municipal Utilities. The Public Service Commission, however, may order rates to be charged that differ from the proposed rates contained in this notice.

Any corporation, association, or person with a substantial interest in the matter may by written request, within thirty (30) days after publication or mailing of this notice of the proposed rate changes to intervene. Intervention may be granted beyond the thirty (30) day period for good cause shown.
