MINUTES OF THE LOCAL PUBLIC HEARING BARDSTOWN HIGH SCHOOL, AUDITORIUM BARDSTOWN, KENTUCKY NOVEMBER 22, 2010 6:00 P.M.

At the outset of the public hearing in the above referenced matter, Andrew Melnykovych, Public Information Officer for the Public Service Commission, welcomed the attendees, introduced the Commission and Commission Staff, and explained the procedure and protocol for the public hearing. Nick Comer, East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc.'s ("EKPC") Public and Media Relations Representative, then provided a general overview of EKPC's base rate application. Following this presentation, members of the public were provided an opportunity to direct questions to EKPC concerning the company's request for a rate increase. Mr. David Hobbs, of Heaven Hill Distilleries, inquired concerning the effect of the proposed rate increase on industrial customers. Mr. Comer responded that rates for industrial customers would increase by approximately 5.3 percent, depending on the member system.

Larry Cook, Assistant Attorney General for the Attorney General's ("AG") Office of Rate Intervention, made a brief explanation of the AG's position concerning EKPC's rate application. A member of the public asked why the AG is of the position that EKPC's proposed rate increase is excessive. Mr. Cook advised that the AG's position

is based on the information gathered during the discovery phase of this case and testimony filed by another intervenor.

Vice-Chairman Jim Gardner then invited the public to make comments to the Commission regarding EKPC's application for a base rate increase. Mr. Hobbs had intended to make a public comment but opted to file written comments instead. No other member of the public wished to make a comment. The public hearing was then adjourned.
