APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF TRANSFER

Pursuant to KRS 278.020(4), Woodland Acres Utilities, LLC, hereby submits to the Public Service Commission of Kentucky (“Commission”) this application for the transfer of the Wastewater Treatment Plant and collection system serving the Woodland Acres Subdivision in Shepherdsville, Bullitt County, Kentucky, to Woodland Acres Utilities, LLC in accordance with the Agreement entered into by and between Charles V. Gibbons, the Executor of the Estate of John Ford and Wanda Ford, the surviving spouse of John Ford, and Joseph Murphy. a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A. In support of its application, Woodland Acres Utilities, LLC, states as follows:

1. John Ford was the owner and operator of the Woodland Acres Wastewater Treatment Plant and collection system (hereinafter “Woodland Acres WWTP”) at the time of his death on October 9, 2008. John Ford was the sole shareholder and officer of Woodland Acres Sanitation, Inc., which owned the Woodland Acres WWTP. Woodland Acres Sanitation, Inc. was administratively dissolved by the Kentucky Secretary of State on November 1, 2000, and since that time, John Ford has owned and operated the Woodland Acres WWTP. (See Exhibit B).
