

CREDIT AND JOURNAL ENTRY**

Comes Woodland Acres Utilities Company, LLC (“Woodland Acres”), by counsel, and for its Motion for Extension of Time to File Irrevocable Letter of Credit and Journal Entry, states as follows:


- 1) The Order entered by the Public Service Commission (“Commission”) in the above-styled case on September 1, 2010 required Woodland Acres to, among other things, file with the Commission an Irrevocable Letter of Credit and the journal entry that records the acquisition of the Woodland Acres Wastewater Treatment Plant within thirty (30) days of September 1, 2010;
- 2) Woodland Acres is working to obtain the required Irrevocable Letter of Credit and also to prepare the required journal entry, but has not yet been able to do so.
- 3) Accordingly, Woodland Acres hereby requests an additional thirty (30) days within which to file the required Irrevocable Letter of Credit and Journal Entry.
