Dear Mr. Collett,



The West Liberty Water Works is again experiencing increasing costs for water treatment and distribution. The cost of utilities and chemicals for water treatment as well as everything else associated with water production has increased steadily since our last rate increase to the Morgan County Water District. We have also experienced several expensive disasters and we feel it will be necessary to increase all of our rates to cover our expenses. We will be raising the rate for the Morgan County Water District from \$2.55 per thousand to \$2.67 per thousand beginning June 1, 2010. Additionally we will increase from \$2.67 per thousand to \$2.79 per thousand beginning January 1, 2011.

We hope you find this rate acceptable and look forward to working with you in the future to deliver quality water to all of our customers. We feel that this increase should, along with an increase to our West Liberty customers, put the West Liberty Water Plant in better financial shape. The numerous emergencies that we have dealt with in the past several years have drained our operations financially.

Our water plant is still ranked in the top for the State in water quality and it is our desire to maintain this standard for the future.
